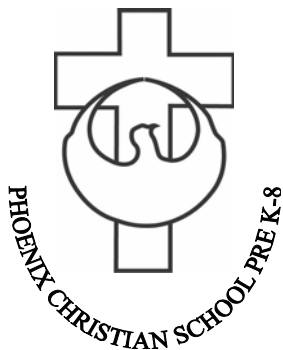

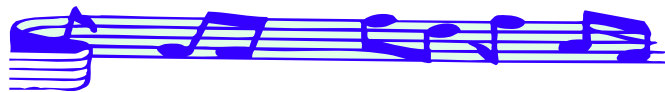

Part-time Grounds Position at PCS... we are looking for someone who can work 20-25 hour a week with flexible hours on afternoons, evenings and Saturday. Duties include

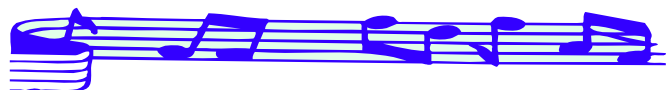
- trimming trees and shrubs
